What is the STEAM Factory?

The STEAM Factory is a diverse and inclusive grass-roots network in the Ohio State community that facilitates creative and interdisciplinary collaboration, innovation and dissemination. The STEAM Factory also provides a space in which people from all disciplines can broaden their perspectives, share resources, spark creative research ideas and form collaborations across areas of common interest, or simply come to learn something new about an intriguingly diverse community!

- 1. To provide opportunities for fun, enriching, adaptive interdisciplinary collaboration that enhances and drives innovation within all research disciplines
- 2. To provide linkages and interactions between departments, centers, schools and colleges
- 3. To increase awareness, understanding, and impact of Ohio State research

What are STEAM Exchanges?

STEAM Exchanges are salon-style gatherings held once per month during academic semesters and hosted by a member of the STEAM Factory. These Exchanges often focus on a broad thematic topic or single subject that can be discussed from multiple disciplinary perspectives. STEAM Exchanges are intended to highlight the current research of STEAM members in relation to the selected topic from different disciplinary perspectives. Presentations may be more traditional seminar-style or interactive demonstrations of creative designs. Outcomes of participation include identifying opportunities for collaboration, sharing of diverse experiences, tools and resources, and enhanced teaching and professional development.

What is the format of STEAM Exchanges?

Typically, **3 faculty/staff from different disciplines** are asked by the host or are self-nominated (totally welcomed!) to present on how a particular topic relates to their individual disciplines and their respective body of work (e.g., research, performance art). **Presenters** should expect to give a **15 minute presentation** of their work targeted to a general audience of people from diverse disciplines, and be open to answering questions and engaging in a lively topical group discussion (typically 20 to 30 attendees). **Attendees** have the opportunity to learn about interesting and unique areas of research and various disciplines in a **lively**, **fun, and informal setting**.

These discussions are informal, engaging and lively, and continue to be a favorite with STEAM Factory members. Exchanges are meant for you to share your excitement about your interests and ignite your imagination amongst and across your STEAM community.
